

WELL-BEING

- More Club Members participate in daily physical activity than youth nationally.*

- 34% of Ludlow middle & H.S. aged youth reported feeling sad/hopeless for 2 weeks or more, compared to 27% of counterparts across the state.
- Across all social-emotional domains, the majority of Club members report high levels of social-emotional skills.*
- 76% of Club youth feel a sense of belonging and emotional safety when at the Club**

National Economic Impact Study (2018 National Youth Outcomes Report, BGCA):

- Every dollar invested in a Club returns \$9.60 in current & future earnings and cost-savings to our community.
- Clubs help increase the earning power of parents, as well as youth when they become adults.
